Medals will be awarded as follows:

Gold Medal 17.0 points and over

- A gold medal beer is an outstanding beer that displays the correct balance of taste, aroma and appearance appropriate for the style, and excellent technical merit.

Silver Medal 15.5 to 16.9 points

- A silver medal beer is an excellent product that displays the correct balance of taste, aroma and appearance appropriate for the style, and a high level of technical merit.

Bronze Medal 14.0 to 15.4 points

- A bronze medal beer is a quality product with the correct balance of taste, aroma and appearance appropriate for the style, and the absence of major faults.
